

Privacy Policy

Information Collection

The Agency will only collect personally identifiable information (such as name, title, company name, address, telephone number, or e-mail address) that you voluntarily provide through mailings, our Website or e-mail correspondence. We may collect general information (such as the type of browser you use, the files you request, and the domain name and country from which you request information) to improve our Web site and better meet your needs.

Use of Information

Before we collect any personally identifiable information, we will provide an explanation for the possible use of your data. The information you supply will be used by The Agency to respond to your inquiries or supply you with requested information on The Agency. Authorized third parties may be used by The Agency to collect, track and process such information. It may be necessary, if required by law or if pertinent to judicial or governmental investigations, to release your personally identifiable information. If you have submitted personal information to The Agency electronically and would like it removed or modified, please contact us. We will use every possible reasonable effort to comply with your request.

How will the information be used?

Who will have access to my information?

The Agency does not rent or sell your personally identifiable information to any third parties. Any access to your information is limited and The Agency retains sole ownership of all of your personally identifiable information.
